Aloha Association Members:

On March 22, 2020, Mayor Victorino announced a “**stay at home and work from home**” amendment to the Public Health Emergency Rules in an effort to fight the spread of COVID-19. The amendment is effective at 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, March 25, 2020 and effective until April 30, 2020.

As such, the Kehalani Community Association office will comply with the rules and close the office from Wednesday, March 25, 2020 thru April 30, 2020. The office will be able to take messages of all calls/emails and respond within a 24 hr. basis, however, action on issues may not be addressed unless in an emergency situation.

The Association has cancelled all meetings during this time period and is viewing its options on the postponement or cancellation of the Annual Meeting that usually occurs in April.

We will be updating the website with information as we move forward.

We are reminded that the Mayor’s amendment orders all to stay/work from home, stay at home or place of lodging except for “essential activities,” “essential businesses” or “government operations”; NO public or private gatherings outside the home.

We are encouraging all of our members and employees to continue to follow the preventive directives outlined by the CDC and the Department of Health that includes:

- a) Wash hands, 20 seconds;
- b) Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands;
- c) Use hand sanitizers, if available;
- d) Cough or sneeze into a tissue or flexed elbow, throw tissue in trash;
- e) Avoid close contact with people, maintain social distancing, especially those who are sick;
- f) Stay home when you are sick;
- g) Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects people frequently touch;
- h) Only wear a face mask if you have respiratory symptoms or are caring for someone with respiratory symptoms.
