

Aloha Kehalani Community Association Homeowners,

As you are aware, the main collector roads and internal subdivision roads in Kehalani have not been dedicated to the County by the builder developers. The current Master Developer, RCFC Kehalani, LLC, through its development manager Dowling Co., Inc., has been working over 8 years to seek road dedication to Maui County. We have been informed that the Maui County Council Water & Infrastructure Committee will be taking up this resolution on May 12, 2025.

The Kehalani Community Association Board of Directors support the dedication of the collector roads to Maui County and is asking that our homeowners support the dedication of the primary collector roadways. In addition to providing access for its residents, the collector roadways within Kehalani are open to the public, serving Pu'u Kukui Elementary School and the County's Kehalani Mauka Park. Dedication of the roadways means that the maintenance costs related to the roads will be borne by the County and not the members of the Kehalani Community Association.

All of the collector roadways of Kehalani were contructed to County standards, however standards havechanged since they were constructed, so dedication now requires approval by the Maui County Council.

Council Member Tom Cook's Water and Infrastructure (WAI) Committee will be hearing Resolution No. 25-86, to accept the dedication of the roadways on MONDAY, MAY 12, 2025.
